INTRODUCTION

The **Sports Experts/Donic Circuit Québécois** is a competition network gathering between 200 and 350 players of all ages, genders and levels in each of 6 tournaments throughout the season.

Employees of the Quebec Table Tennis Federation oversee all aspects of the Circuit.

MATCHES

- The order of play is indicated on the pad handed out to players at each table. When a player is absent, skip to the next match to be played.
- A 2-minute warm-up is allowed before each match.
- Players are responsible for umpiring each other's matches.
- In an initial pool, each player should umpire the same amount of matches. Penalties can apply to players refusing to do so.
- All matches are best of 5 with sets of 11 points.



EQUIPMENT

TABLES: We only play on professional-grade tables. Although we cannot guarantee on which brand of table you will play, we wish to thank our main sponsor who provided us with **24 DONIC COMPACT 25 tables** within the last two years.

BALLES: DONIC P40+ 3 stars ABS.



GENERAL INFORMATION

ALL PARTICIPANTS

- Agree to comply with the QTTF code of ethics, as well as ITTF regulations.
- Must a valid member of the QTTF or another provincial federation at the time of the tournament.
- Must pay their registration BEFORE starting their first match. Failure to do so can prevent them from playing; a penalty fee of \$10 applies for late payment.
- Who withdraw less than 72 hours before the tournament starts, or do not show up, must pay an administration fee of \$15 in addition to their registration to register again for another QTTF event.
- Authorize the QTTF to use for editorial purposes (web, social networks, etc.) the pictures taken during its tournaments.
- Who win a rating-based category can register for the immediately higher category in the same time slot at the next QTTF calendar tournament only. They must notify registration officials if they wish to use this privilege, which cannot be transferred to another tournament later in the year.
- Must register for the rating-based category that reflects their ranking, except for cases where the over-ranking rule applies.

CATÉGORIES

Gold, silver and bronze medals in all singles categories.
Gold and silver medals only in team matches.

SINGLES BY DIVISION

9:00 AM to 2:30 PM

Fee: \$30

- "Blind" registration: the 32 highest rated players registered from divisions A and B. The next 32 players from divisions C and D, and so on.
- Initial pools of 4 players.
- All players survive initial pools!
- Best two records of each pool advance in the stronger division (e.g., A) and the other two in the weaker division (e.g., B).
- Single-elimination draw of 16 players per division.
- Should players be absent in a division, they will not be replaced and tournament officials will make no modifications after posting the pools.

PRIZE MONEY FOR DIVISION A

- 1ST PLACE ▶ \$750
- 2ND PLACE ▶ \$250
- 3RD PLACE ▶ \$100

SINGLES BY RATINGS

2:30 PM to 8:00 PM

Fee: \$25

- Registration in the closed category reflecting your current Canadian rating.
- New players get an initial rating of 100.
- Players 18 and up can register in a higher category by paying an additional fee of \$15.

TEAM MATCHES

9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Fee : \$35/player

- Blind registration.
- **The QTTF does NOT find partners for you.**
- Teams are comprised of 2 players.
- Teams are automatically assigned to a division (A, B, C, etc.) based on the total rating of both players.
- Each player plays a singles match against each opposing player.
- If there is a tie after the 4 singles matches, a doubles match is played to determine the winning team.
- Teams must chose before the first match who is A or B (or X or Y).

Order of play:

- A vs X
- B vs Y
- A vs Y
- B vs X
- AB vs XY (only if necessary)
